About Firefighters For Healing



Hands down, Roger Federer. He makes tennis look effortless, and Tennis can be very physical. I really enjoy the workout I can get he's really gracious, whether he's wins or loses. A great role model. from an intense tennis match. And tennis is a very mental sport. There are shot selections and patterns that we practice and What have you learned from participating in this sport? learn. It challenges me physically and mentally.

My parents always encouraged me to try multiple sports. Soccer, golf, baseball...I enjoyed them all, but at about 10 years of age, I decided that I was going to devote my time to being the best tennis player I could be.

Being a competitive tennis player has taught me valuable skills. I've had to learn to be disciplined and dedicated; I've worked very hard on mental and physical toughness...12 months a year, six days a week we practiced, sometimes before school, always after school and on the weekends. I had to learn to balance school, homework, sleep, and since, as my mom would say, I'm somewhat of a social butterfly, and I needed to find a way to spend downtime with my family and friends. Luckily for me, most of my best friends also participated in tennis with me.

Something else I've learned is to win and lose graciously. After a tennis match is over, it's tradition that the players meet at the net



and shake hands. There are only one winner and one loser, and I've been on both sides; it can be hard to congratulate and shake the hand of someone you just lost to, but tennis teaches us to be good sports win or lose.

What do you like most about the sport?

I think there's a misconception that tennis isn't a very hard or physical sport, but it takes a lot physically, especially if you're playing singles. Throughout the years, I've had to deal with many tennis-related injuries, and I've had to sit out many tournaments/ competitions due to injuries sometimes for months, and as I'd sit on the sidelines cheering my friends on, I would always be thinking I wish that was me out there! That's what I like -- even with setbacks, it's a passion for the sport that I didn't want to give up.

I also like that it's a lifelong sport...and it can be very social.

What do you plan on doing after graduation?

After high school graduation, I knew I wanted to continue competing in tennis, so I am still playing in college. After college, I think my parents would like it if I got a job and became an "adult." I'll probably still play tennis but at a more casual level.

One tip for someone looking to get into this sport:

I'd say to parents...start your children young and learn the game yourself; it's a sport the whole family can enjoy together.

Meet Mary Battista of Prairie Health Companion!




